ABOUT US



Kaos Produzioni is an arts research group that designs and creates multimedia, theatrical and exhibition projects and undertakes the production and direction of audio visual works. It also investigates new technologies and applies them to aesthetic and exhibition enhancement projects for museums, public and private spaces.

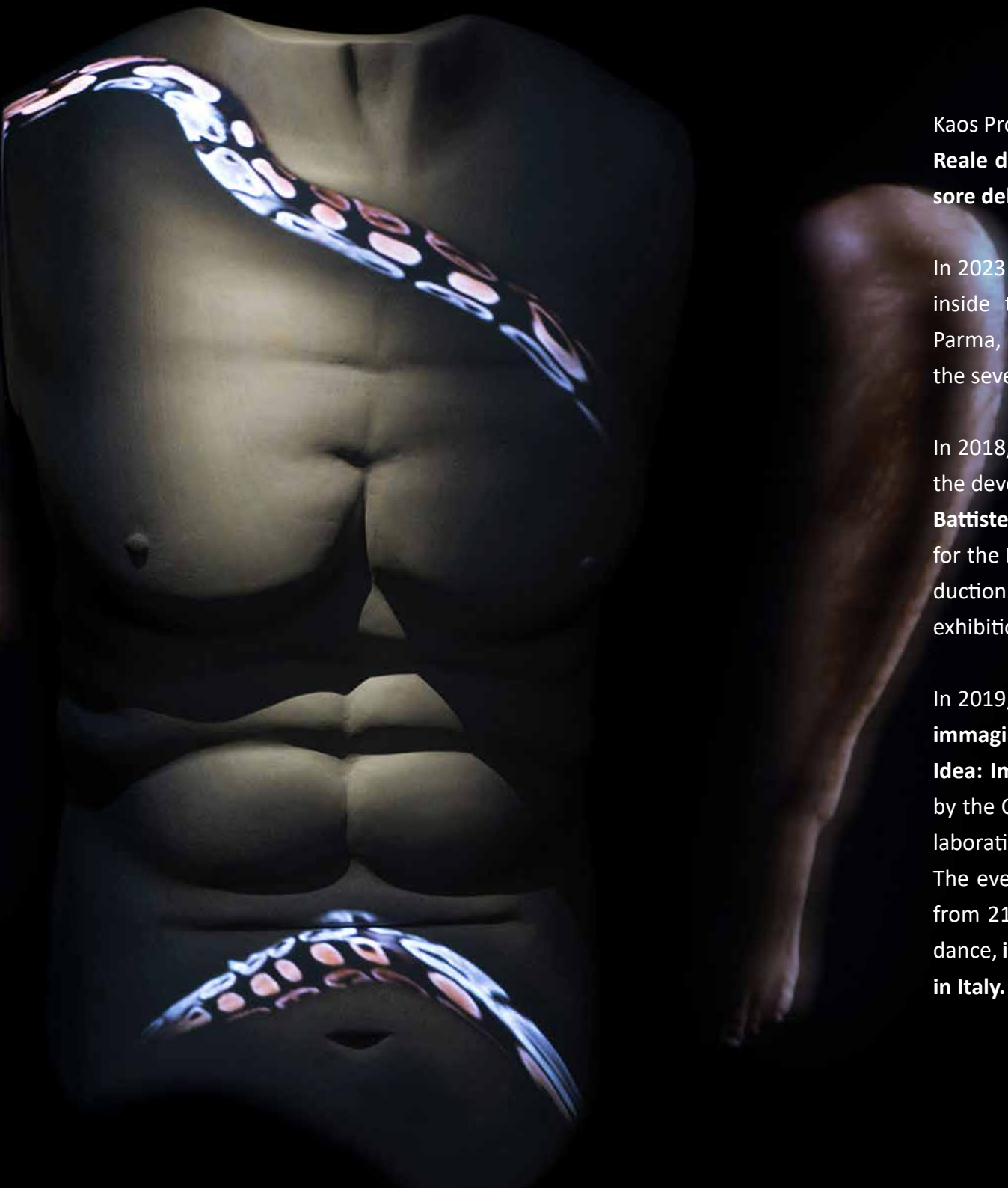
Based in Milan and Naples, Kaos Produzioni was founded in 2010 by its artistic director Stefano Gargiulo. A Set Design graduate from the Brera Academy of Fine Arts, his path over the years has been to develop aesthetic connections between space as a site of representation and multimedia tools, applying them to installation and narrative projects and to the enhancement of artistic and cultural heritage.

Stefano Gargiulo has gained a wealth of experience in international projects since the mid-1990s, not only in Europe and the Mediterranean area, but also in Argentina, Brazil, the United States and Indonesia.

Since 2013 he has been an adjunct lecturer on the Exhibitions and Installations course at the Fondazione Scuole Civiche del Cinema e Multimedia in Milan, and in 2021 he taught Multimedia Design at the Academy of Fine Arts in Reggio Calabria.

In recent years he created Kaos Produzioni, a crossmedia laboratory involving professionals from all over the country.





Kaos Produzioni has currently opened to the public, at the **Palazzo Reale di Napoli**, the interactive vertical video installation **L'ascensore del Re**.

In 2023 they designed and realised a permanent video installation inside the stage and proscenium of the Farnese Theater in Parma, one of the most extraordinary theatrical architectures of the seventeenth century.

In 2018, a new partnership with the **Capodimonte Museum** led to the development of several projects: video installations for the **Battistello Caracciolo** exhibition in June 2022; the video installation for the **Luca Giordano** exhibition in 2020; and the design and production of the videomapping installation for the "Napoli Napoli..." exhibition in the museum's **Cradle Hall** in 2019.

In 2019, Kaos Produzioni curated the exhibition **Il Corpo dell'Idea, immaginazione e linguaggio in Vico e Leopardi/The Body of the Idea: Imagination and Language in Vico and Leopardi**, produced by the Campania Region and the National Library of Naples in collaboration of MANN (National Archaeological Museum of Naples). The event was held at the Sala Dorica of Palazzo Reale in Naples from 21 March to 21 July 2019. With 20,000 spectators in attendance, **it was the most visited exhibition of philosophy and poetry in Italy.**



In 2017, Kaos Produzioni began the task of transforming the **Spazi '900** permanent museum of the **Central National Library in Rome** into a dynamic exhibition space, with newly imagined interpretive environments on Elsa Morante, Pier Paolo Pasolini and in 2018 Umberto Saba and Carlo Levi.

They were responsible for the design and direction of the short film: *Caro Gioachino...* produced by Teatro San Carlo in collaboration with Rai Cinema to mark the 150th anniversary of the death of Rossini. The film was presented at the Venice Days section of the **75th Venice Film Festival in 2018**.

In 2016 they designed and realised the **Kaleidos** permanent multimedia museum as a mainstay of the "Il Cartastorie" museum of the **Fondazione Archivio Storico del Banco di Napoli**. This is the first ever instance of an functioning archive becoming a museum that welcomes visitors. The project led to his winning the 2016 Culture and Business Prize. In 2017, it was awarded the highest European distinction in the field of cultural heritage enhancement: **The European Union Prize for Cultural Heritage / Europa Nostra Awards 2017**", and the **Financial Cultural Heritage Certificate (FCH) 2017**.

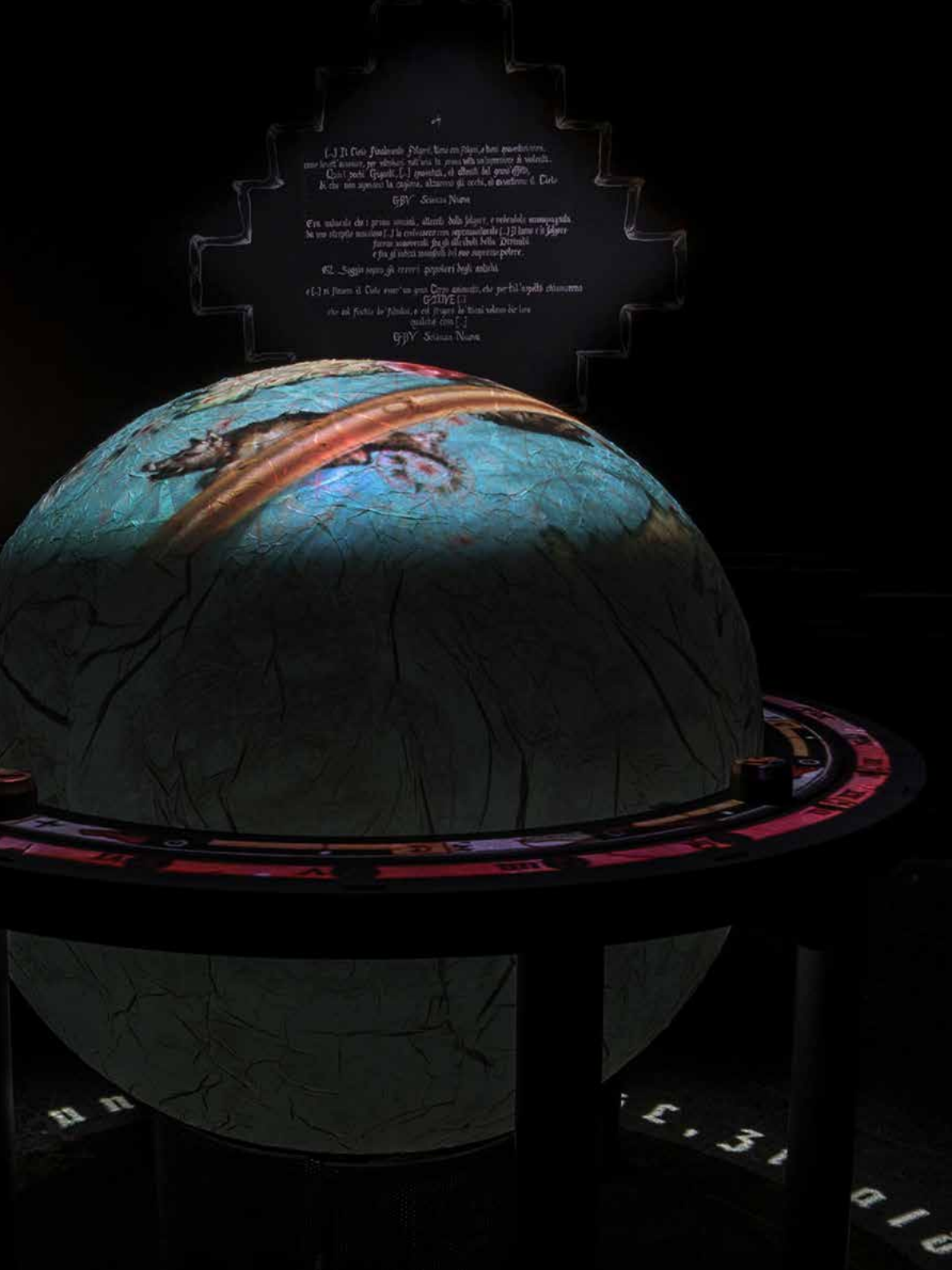
